The Elections of the Indian Body Builders Federations Executive Committee were held at Ludhiana, Punjab on 26th August 2016. Well known Advocate Rakesh Kosamkar was appointed as the Returning officer by the Indian Body Builders Federation. As the Returning Officer to conduct the elections in accordance with Bye-laws as formulated by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Sports Code 2011 and the constitution of the Indian Body Builders Federation.

The Election was conducted in a fare, free and transparent manner. As far as the Posts of the President, Executive Vice President, Vice President, General Secretary, Associate Secretary and Organising Secretary, the elections were unanimous.

Shri Premchand Degra (Padmashri, Arjun Awardee) of Punjab was elected as the President, Shri Chetan M.
